Program overview

Recognized as a national leader in alcohol and chemical dependency treatment programs, Geisinger Marworth's Outpatient Department provides comprehensive programs in the outpatient setting to accommodate individual needs and unique personal situations. Highly specialized outpatient and intensive outpatient programs incorporate the individual's circumstances and needs, while recognizing future obstacles to recovery.

Our approach addresses the problem that brings the individual to treatment, and keeps the individual focused on recovery. Founded on the knowledge that addiction is a primary and progressive disease, our outpatient programs are designed to be firm yet compassionate, reinforcing the premise that the disease is treatable and can be held in continuous remission.

Level of care

Treatment plans are developed from a detailed assessment that identifies the best course of action for each individual. Individuals are evaluated according to guidelines and protocols established by the American Society of Addiction Medicine and the Diagnostic Statistical Manual 5 of the American Psychiatric Association. These guidelines and protocols ensure individuals are directed to the most appropriate level of care for their particular stage of the disease process.

Geisinger Marworth offers two levels of outpatient treatment programs. The two levels of treatment are structured to meet individual needs as well as work schedules. Our outpatient treatment programs are designed for both continuing care following residential treatment or for those initiating treatment on their own.

Outpatient Program

**Monday – Friday • 8 a.m. – 9 p.m.
(depending on availability)**

The Outpatient Program is designed for adults who require ongoing support in an outpatient treatment environment.

Services

- Drug and alcohol screenings and evaluations for adults and adolescents
- Individual therapy
- Family therapy
- Healthcare professional group therapy
- Men's and women's group therapy

Intensive Outpatient Program

Program length is three to four weeks, depending upon individual. Daytime and evening programs are available.

The Intensive Outpatient Program is designed for adults requiring a more intensive treatment structure.

Services

- Educational therapy
- Individual therapy (weekly)
- Group therapy (four times per week)
- Family night (weekly session includes lecture and group therapy)

Family Education Program

Tuesdays • 6 – 7:30 p.m.

Individuals and families affected by addiction are invited to this free and open forum to hear from people in recovery and to discuss various topics, including communication skills and problem-solving; family rules and roles; spirituality; stress management and healthy leisure; treating the disease of chemical dependency; and what to expect in early recovery.
